## Report

Things got a bit tedious when they scored a third try a few minutes later with another straightforward conversion (0-31). For the rest of the half, Renegades dug deep and the defence held against the Cantabs onslaught. Towards the end Ben Powell had a great break and, with one defender to beat, offloaded to Tom Heathcote who could only get fingertips to the ball and watched in frustration as it fell for a knock on.

The scoreline was very harsh on Renegades, the performance was much better than it indicates. The forwards were more than a match for the Cantabs forwards in play, the scrum was good in parts.
