Report

The promised bad weather was holding off as Renegades and Cantabs gathered for the last game of the first half or the league. The Cantabs first team didn't have a game so quite a few of them rocked up to run out for the seconds. This would be a challenging fixture for Renegades.

Renegades kicked off into the wind which was blowing towards the school. The contest was fierce from the outset with both teams fighting hard to gain ground and the ball changed hands repeatedly. Eventually, a Cantabs penalty saw then open their account, 0-3.

Renegades upped their pressure in response and worked their way into the Cantabs 22. There a penalty saw Baz bring the sides level again, 3-3.

Once that was under control, he received a welldeserved yellow card for his trouble. Baz converted the penalty, 6-3.











A while later a Renegades lineout on the right side of the pitch saw clean ball to Baz who fed Harry making one of his characteristic lightening runs. This time the defence was unable to catch him, and he cut through Cantabs and under the posts to score. Baz made light work of the conversion, 13-3.

As the rain sheeted down, the referee blew for half time and Renegades made for the shelter of a tree to escape the deluge. Michael Did-Dell came off, Jake moved to the wing and Ryan Cox came on on the flank.

Early in the second half, Farmer Sam made a lovely break through the Cantabs line and hared off down the pitch. As he approached the full-back he dinked it over his head and then hacked it towards the Cantabs line. Ollie was with him in hot pursuit. The pressure of Sam and Ollie forced a Cantabs defender to welly the ball over his own dead ball line. The 5m scrum followed but Cantabs managed to clear the ball to relieve the pressure.

A penalty for Cantabs inside the Renegades 22 missed but was followed shortly by a try in the right corner. The challenging conversion was well struck, and the ball sailed between the posts, 13-10. Ben Powell came on for Farmer Sam.

A couple of further penalties for Cantabs were given, the first missed but the second levelled the score at 13-13. Ryan Cox was forced off when his dodgy knee flared up making way for Fabs. Fabs wasn't long on the field when his opposite flanker elbowed him in the head. Fabs retaliated with a punch. Fortunately, only the Cantabs player received a yellow card. Baz slotted the subsequent penalty, 16-13.

That's how it remained until the final whistle. The delighted reaction of some Renegades when the final whistle blew was an indication of the closeness of the competition. Or maybe they were just delighted to get off the freezing wet pitch.
